CREAMY CAESAR DRESSING



Use this recipe to whip together a quick semi-homemade dressing in a pinch. This dressing comes in handy as an easy weeknight dinner on romaine lettuce with some rotisserie chicken. Whether you use it as a dip for veggies or just make some and store in the refrigerator for later, this recipe is sure to satisfy!

INGREDIENTS:

1 Cup Mayo
1 Tbsp Worcestershire Sauce
¼ teaspoon Dijon Mustard
1 Garlic Clove chopped
Fresh Lemon Juice ½ Lemon
¼ Cup Grated Parm Cheese
Pinch Salt
Pinch Pepper
Croutons
Romaine Lettuce

STEPS

In a small bowl, combine mayonnaise, garlic, worcestershire sauce, dijon mustard, lemon juice, parmesan cheese, salt and pepper.
Set aside in the refrigerator
Chop romaine lettuce
Combine lettuce with dressing and stir
Add croutons, a sprinkle of parm cheese, some freshly cracked pepper and enjoy!
