Dear Scholarship Coordinator/Counselors/Students:

The NABSTMC Southern New Jersey Chapter of Buffalo Soldiers Motorcycle Club (SNJBSMC) is one of 25 chapters in the Northeast Frontier of the National Association of Buffalo Soldiers and Troopers Motorcycle Club (NABSTMC).

The Southern New Jersey Chapter will award four scholarships to graduating high school or trade school seniors residing in the chapter's service area (Atlantic, Cape, Cumberland, Camden, Salem, or Gloucester Counties). Please encourage your students to apply.

SNJBSMC will mail funds to the successful student winner upon transcript verification at the college/university the student will be attending. The scholarship will be awarded based on a completed application packet, which includes financial need, student qualifications, an essay, and supporting documentation.

The selected scholarship recipient will be automatically submitted for consideration and vetting for the Northeast Frontier and/or NABSTMC scholarship programs. All applicants will be notified, and a formal scholarship award presentation will be announced to the recipient, their family, and their high school for an individual presentation.

By March 21, all completed applications and required documents must be scanned in PDF format into ONE (1) PDF file and emailed on or before the stated deadline. Unofficial transcripts can be scanned in PDF format. JPEG and GIF image formats will be rejected.

Completed applications and required documents must be emailed no later than March 21st to the email listed below. Late and/or incomplete packets will be eliminated.

Scholarship Application Instructions for Candidates:

The following are required to complete your application:

- Applicant must be an eligible Graduating High School Senior/GED recipient during the 2024 Fall / 2024 Summer school year who will attend post-secondary or vocational/trade school in 2025 with a minimum GPA of 2.0.
- Attach or scan the completed application only (typically page 3 through page 5); do not include the general information and instructions pages.
- Unofficial High School or Home School transcript or GED Certificate.
- A 500-word essay (typewritten) on one of the topics described below:
****Do not write about the Buffalo Soldiers or Troopers Motorcycle Club****
 - A. What impact did the Buffalo Soldiers make in war and/or peacetime? Why is it necessary to pass this legacy on to future generations?
 - B. Provide specific examples of how the Buffalo Soldiers facilitated the development of roadways, national parks, and mail service.
 - C. The Medal of Honor is presented to the recipient by the President of the United States in the name of Congress. Please provide a brief narrative regarding a Buffalo Soldier who received this honor and what can be learned from his/her life, efforts, and commitment to duty.
- Letter of recommendation on official letterhead from a teacher/guidance counselor/school administrator.
- Letter of recommendation on letterhead from a community service organization
- A letter of acceptance to an institution of higher learning
- Signed Release Form (enclosed)
- Parent's signature, if student is under 18 years of age
- Prepare a letter of introduction, who you are, your accomplishments to date, your family background, and the degree/certificate you seek. Provide a summary of how you plan to use the scholarship if selected. Also, incorporate how this scholarship would benefit you in giving back to your community.
- Recent professional headshot photo (in good taste)
- Provide the Student's name, the complete name and address of the school and/or financial aid office where the student will be attending school, and the student ID number
- Complete all forms in its entirety. Attach additional pages if required.
- Incomplete packages will automatically be eliminated.

Submit Application:

By March 21, all completed applications and required documents must be scanned in PDF format into ONE (1) PDF file and emailed, on or before the stated deadline of March 21, 2025. Unofficial transcripts can be scanned in PDF format. JPEG and GIF image formats will be rejected.
